RULES AND REGULATIONS

Three Man Fall Back Scramble

[WHAT IS A FALLBACK SCRAMBLE?](#)

Men start from the white tees and ladies start from the red. If on the first hole you birdie you fallback one tee on the second hole. If you bogie you fall forward on the next tee and if you par you stay on the same tee as the first hole. If you eagle you still only move one tee at a time. Ladies never fall back past the white tees, however the men can fall forward or backwards on all Six sets of tees. This is the same format that is used in our monthly tournament the "Westminster Open".

"ABSOLUTELY NO" Outside Beverages will be allowed!

FORMAT: 3 Person Fallback Scramble (two teams, 6 players per hole)

The first two weeks of play will be used to flight the League. Based on participation there will be at least two flights. The event will be scored as follows: If on the first night of play your team comes in at 2 under par, then your score is 2 under par. The second week your team is 3 under par, then after two weeks your team is now 5 under for the League. If on the third week your team comes in 1 over par, then, your running team score is now 4 under par. This format continues throughout the season and winners are determined at the end of the year based on their final under or over par for the summer.

All players shall abide by the Westminster dress code. Jeans, jogging wear, gym shorts and T-shirts are NOT allowed. You cannot play unless in proper attire. *NO EXCEPTIONS!*

The cost for League is \$20.00 per night. This price is only good for League night, *not any other day of the week*. If you wish to come and play nine holes before the League, you may do so, and the price will be \$10.00 + tax for that nine and does not include a free draft/soda for \$10.00. You must check in and pay BEFORE you play!! You may not play the nine you are scheduled to play in League; that is considered practice and is not permitted.

League player's benefits and information:

- Will start promptly at 5:30
- Includes a free Draft/Soda after golf
- ½ price range balls - \$3.00 Sm. & \$4.50 Lg.
- Green and Cart fees included
- Skins game (by flights) Optional \$2.00 per man (All Players have to be in skins)
- Closest to the flagstick game (by flights) Optional \$2.00 per man (Individual)
- **Includes a Non-Season Pass (May 1st to December 31st) for golf anytime for \$26.00 +tax!**
- **Includes a Season Pass (January 1st to April 30th 2013) for golf anytime for \$55.00 +tax!**
- \$20.00 each night includes tax!
- Sign-up by Monday April 16th (free beer on the 16th for sign-up or sign-up before then)
- League ends September 28th
- \$50.00 Initiation Fee is required. This is 100% payback for the banquet, food, and prize money at the end of the season.
- All players are allowed to miss a **maximum** of two nights of league without paying their \$20.00 fee for league. If you have a sub and the sub pays the \$20.00 fee for that night, this is **not** counted as a missed night or you can pay the \$20.00 the following week..
- Any player that misses more than two nights without paying the \$20.00 fee will forfeit their **"IN-Season"** pass for playing golf for \$55.00 +tax, for the 2012-2013 Season, January 1st to April 30th. Cancellation of league due to weather is not considered a missed night and there will be no charge.

All players are responsible for checking in at the Pro Shop prior to teeing off.

All USGA Rules apply.

The course is well marked. Play the course as you find it. It is the responsibility of each and every player to play according to the USGA rules, and to question other players if they feel they are in breach of a rule. If there is a question about a rule, then play two balls and get a ruling when you come into the Clubhouse and adjust your score then. When knowingly playing a shot that is in breach of a rule, that player loses that hole. *This is a gentlemen's game and the integrity of the game should be kept intact.*

The Friday Night League Season will start April 20th and end Sept 28th. In the event we have weeks cancelled due to rain, there will be only two make-up dates. League will be extended by only two weeks and last night of league WILL be Sept 30th.

WEATHER: Summer brings the summer rains along with dangerous lightning. Because it is raining in Cape Coral, North Ft Myers and Bonita or where ever, does not mean it is raining here. In the event play has started and the weather turns for the worst, Steve Gard and/or Tim Perkins (no one else) will be responsible to protect the golfers and call off play. If we do have league and you choose not to come because it is raining where you are, you will not receive any score for that night, this will be considered a "missed night" and nor will you be able to make up the night on another night. In 2009 and 2010 league was rained out only TWICE ALL SUMMER. If five holes have been completed, it is considered a match. If

less than five holes are completed it is considered a wash and no scores will be posted for the night. There will be no other matches played outside of Friday night. In the event bad weather cancels League for that night, then that match will be scheduled and played the next week and all matches will be pushed back.

Steve Gard and Tim Perkins will manage all funds and report to the League in the managing of those funds.

Anyone who acts inappropriately toward another player, Pro Shop personnel, Restaurant personnel, and Beverage Cart personnel or damages the course or golf carts **WILL** be expelled from the League without any refund. Any inappropriate conduct will not be tolerated.

All carts will be assigned by numbers located on the sides of the cart to all players. In the event there is any damage done to the carts, the players in the carts will be responsible for any and all damages.
